1. Safety, Sobriety, and adherence to the law	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *No tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs *No weapons of any kind (including pocket knives) *No students are allowed to drive at events *Vandalism or destruction of property will be replaced at student's expense *Students are to be in groups of 3 or more at all times 	<p>The consequences for breaking the values #1 and #4 is to be sent home</p> <p style="text-align: center;">.....</p> <p>For the rest of these, there will be a 3-strike plan during an event</p>
2. Modesty	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Girls- One piece swimsuits or tankini that covers all abdomen *Guys- No Speedos *Modest clothing choices that are suited for the activity 	
3. Group Unity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *No leaving camp/event without a leader and/or prior arrangement (includes Sunday school, confirmation, and small groups) *No personal game or music devices at events. Cell phones can be brought, but must be off and put away-they will be confiscated if found being used *Full participation is expected at all events *Gossiping, swearing, and hurtful talk is not permitted. If it is not true, necessary, or kind, please don't say it 	<p>Strike 1 -have a "heart check" talk with leader and youth director</p> <p>Strike 2 - Student and youth director call home</p> <p>Strike 3 - Student is sent home</p> <p>It is the responsibility (incl. financial) of the parents to pick up their student, or arrange ride home.</p>
4. Privacy and Discretion	*No boys in girls' sleeping areas and vice versa	
5. Purity	*No co-ed seating in vehicles after dark and no PDA ("purple") at any time	
6. Order / Respect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Leaders authority is to be respected, youth director has the final say in questionable matters * Students must respect building or space we are occupying (pick up after themselves)
